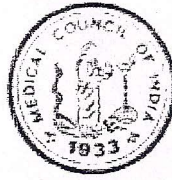

Sub. Continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune was carried out by the Council Assessors on 17th June, 2016. The compliance verification assessment report (17th June, 2016) along with the previous assessment report (16th & 17th Feb., 2016) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 30.06.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 22nd November, 2016:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (17th June, 2016) along with the previous assessment report (16th & 17th Feb., 2016) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune be continued restricting the number of admission to 140 (One Hundred Forty) students.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

The above decision of the General Body has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 28.04.2017.
