

**ADMISSION NOTICE : SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES AT AFMC, PUNE THROUGH
CENTRAL COUNSELING BY DGHS, MoHFW FOR THE YEAR 2018**

1. Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC), Pune conducts Post-Doctoral/Superspeciality training primarily for the doctors of Armed Forces Medical Services.

2. **Eligibility Criteria** The eligibility criteria for admission to Superspeciality courses at AFMC, Pune are :-

(a) **Categories**

(i) **Serving officers of the AFMS** : AFMS officers granted study leave.

(ii) **Medical Officers sponsored by Para Military Forces/other Govt. of India organizations** : A Sponsorship Certificate as per **Appx 'A'** issued by the sponsoring authority to the candidate, specific to the subject allotted, is a mandatory requirement for admission.

(iii) **Ex-SSC AFMS officers** :

- Officers released from service after completion of contractual service, within three years after the release from service are eligible for admission with no service/bond liability. The date of release should not be before 01 Aug 2015 for the session starting from August 2018.
- Officers who have resigned the commission/dismissed/removed from service/ not completed the contractual service are **NOT ELIGIBLE** under this category.
- AFMS officers with date of release from service prior to 01 Aug 2015 will have service/bond liability as applicable to civilian doctors.

(iv) **Civilian doctors** :

- The candidate should be willing to serve the Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for 05 years subject to fulfilling other eligibility criteria. Candidate will have to execute a bond agreement as per **Appx 'B'** at the time of admission, to pay a sum of Rs. Thirty Four Lacs (Rs. 34,00,000/-) to Govt. of India, in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course. Maximum permissible age shall be 40 yrs as on 01 Aug 2018.
- **Civilian doctors will have to undergo medical examination by duly constituted medial board at the time of admission, so as to assess their fitness for commissioning as per laid down criteria and will be admitted only if found fit**

Authority: GoI letter No. F/PC-8510/DGAFMS/DG-1D/345/2013/D(Med) dated 6th March 2013 and GoI letter No. PC III/17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D/1819/13(a)/D (Med) dated 15 January 2014.

(b) **Qualifications** : Candidate must have MBBS & MD/MS/DNB Degrees registered with State Medical Council or MCI. Students who have completed/are competing Post-Graduation by 31 Jul 2018 are eligible for admission alongwith Provisional Registration Certificate.

(c) The candidate must be a citizen of India.

(d) A candidate who is already pursuing any Superspeciality course, shall not be eligible for admission to another Superspeciality course in the Academic Year 2018-19.

3. **SEATS & RECOGNITION STATUS:** AFMC Pune is recognized by the Medical Council of India (MCI) and is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik for the following Scourses :-

(a)	DM (Cardiology)	:	01
(b)	MCh (Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery)	:	03
(c)	MCh (Neurosurgery)	:	03
(d)	MCh (Plastic Surgery)	:	03

4. **COUNSELING:** As per the Govt of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare letter No. V.26012/02/2016 MEP (Pt) dated 04 May 2017; there shall be a common counseling for all seats of NEET-Superspeciality at National level to be conducted by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS). Hence, all eligible candidates desirous of admission to Post-Doctoral courses (DM/MCh) at Armed Forces Medical College (AFMC, Pune) for the session commencing from Aug 2018 will have to register on portal for Superspeciality courses on the MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in.

5. **PROCESS OF ADMISSION AND MEDICAL EXAMINATION**

The following process will be adopted by candidates :-

(a) All candidates seeking admission should register on the portal for Supespeciality courses on MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they meet the requisite eligibility criteria.

(b) Candidates while reporting for admission will have to bring the following documents :-

- (i) 06 (Six) passport size latest photographs.
- (ii) Copy of the NEET-SS 2018 Admit card.
- (iii) NEET-SS 2018 Score Card.
- (iv) Copy of Class X/SSLC/ICSE certificate as valid certificate of proof of age.
- (v) Copy of University Mark Sheet of first to final MBBS examinations and Post-Graduation course.
- (vi) Copy of Internship Completion Certificate.
- (vii) Copy of Permanent /Provisional state Medical Council Registration Certificate of MBBS & Post graduation course
- (viii) Copy of MBBS & Post-Graduation degrees (Passing Certificate if degree has not been received.)
- (ix) Copy of Nationality Certificate/Xerox copy of valid Passport/Domicile Certificate/Birth Certificate.
- (x) Copy of Attempt Certificate (MBBS & MD/MS/DNB as applicable).
- (xi) Copy of Transfer Certificate for non-AFMC candidates.
- (xii) Copy of Migration certificate for non-MUHS candidates.
- (xiii) Copy of Aadhaar Card.
- (xiv) Sponsorship Certificate in case of Medical Officers sponsored by Para-Military Forces/Govt. of India organization. Sponsorship Certificate issued by the sponsoring authority should be specific to the subject allotted and is a mandatory requirement for the candidate to be considered for admission as a sponsored candidate.
- (xv) In case of Ex-AFMS/SSC Officers, release order from Armed Forces Medical Services issued by DGAFMS/concerned Medical Directorate.
- (xvi) Civilian candidates, if selected, will be required to execute a bond agreement at the time of admission, to pay a sum of **Rs. Thirty Four Lacs Only (Rs. 34,00,000/-)** to Govt. of India, in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course as per **GoI Letter No: PCIII/17436/DGAFMS/DG1D/1819/13/(a)/D (Medical) dated 15 January 2014.**

Note: Admission to DM/MCh courses at AFMC Pune is provisional subject to confirmation/ratification by the O/o DGAFMS, MUHS Nashik & MCI. Candidates are free to seek any clarification before accepting a seat during counseling.

6. **ANTEDATE SENIORITY FOR CIVILIAN DOCTORS COMMISSIONED IN AFMS**

The civilian doctors, on grant of commission in the Armed Forces, will be eligible to apply for ante date seniority within 01 year of grant of Short Service Commission, in accordance with GoI Letter No. 3569/DGAFMS/DG 1b(i)/3394/D(med) dated 20th December 2011 as under :-

- (a) **PG Degree** - 36 months (for NBE/MCI recognized PG degree obtained from a recognized institution after a PG Degree course of 03 years duration)

- (b) **PG Diploma** - 24 months (for NBE/MCI recognized PG Diploma obtained from a recognized institution after a PG Diploma course of 02 years duration)
- (c) Maximum antedate seniority in case of a candidate eligible for antedate under more than one counts as given in AI 74/76 & AI 75/78 read with paras 5 (a) & (b) above, will be limited to a total period of 42 months (DGAFMS is the final authority regarding grant of Antedate seniority to any officer).

2. And whereas the post-doctoral Students has undertaken to join and continue Post-
doctoral studies in accordance with rules and regulations of the Maharashtra university of
Health Sciences, Nashik/Armed Forces Medical College for obtaining DM/MCh in
_____ (Subject) of the
_____ (Name of University) and join the Armed Forces Medical Services
as a short service commissioned Officer on successful completion of the course if found
medically fit for the same. And whereas in consideration of the government having agreed to
sanction the admission to the said post-doctoral student, the candidate along with the surety
has agreed to execute the above bond with such conditions as hereunder written.

(a) That in consideration of the Post-doctoral students being admitted by the Govt. to
Armed Forces Medical College, Pune for the purpose of obtaining post-doctoral degree the
post-doctoral student and surety covenant with the Government that the said Post-
doctoral student will attend the Armed Forces Medical College, Pune for obtaining post-
doctoral degree and such other training as Government may determine from time-to-time
for the prescribed period until he/she successfully completes his/her post-doctoral
degree course and is declared fit (as to which the decision of Director General Armed
Forces Medical Services shall be final) to be granted Short Services Commission and
that the Post-doctoral student will be commissioned as a Medical Officer in the regular
Indian Army or the Indian Navy or India Air Forces as SSC Officers unless he/she, the
post-doctoral student is prevented from doing so on account of ill health or some other
reason over which he/she, the post-doctoral student has no control as determined by a
service medical board (as to which the Government shall be the sole judge) or by being
removed on the ground that the student is considered by the appropriate authority to the
unfit to continue as post-doctoral student, or any other ground, to be granted a
commission.

(b) That in the event of the post-doctoral student refusing to accept commission in
the Armed Forces Medical Services on successful completion of his/her post-doctoral
student course the post-doctoral student and the Surety shall jointly be liable to pay and
refund forthwith to the Government of India on demand and without demur in cash an
amount of Rupees Thirty Four Lacs as per Govt. of India letter No.
PCIII/17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D/1819/13(a)/D(Med) dated 15 January 2014.

(c) That the post-doctoral student shall on successful completion of his/her post-
doctoral degree course will report within such period, as may be allowed by the

Director General Armed Forces Medical Services as joining time to the unit or station as specified in this behalf by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services for grant of Short Service Commission on terms and conditions set out in Army Instruction 75/78 and amended time-to-time.

(d) That if the post-doctoral student after grant of short service commission applies for release from service within Five years of grant said commission for any reason whatsoever and provided his/ her release is sanctioned by the Govt of India, as per rules in force, he/ she shall be relieved only after he/ she has refunded bond money at the rate of **Rs. Six Lakhs Eighty Thousand per completed year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability limited** to the bond money as contained in the bond agreement executed at the of admission.

(e) That if the post-doctoral student leaves the institution without completing the course due to any reason after the last date of admission to the post-doctoral course as specified by MCI/ affiliated University, he/ she will be required to pay a sum of **Rs. Six Lakhs Eighty Thousand per year or part thereof of** the education at the institution based on extant rules.

(f) That the post-doctoral student made Non service Liability (NSL) on medical grounds will be required to pay bond money at 50% of amount laid down , before he/ she is allowed to continue his/her studies. However, in case of student becoming medically unfit for commission due to any disease or disability contracted in the circumstances over which he/ she has no control (on which the decision of the DGAFMS shall be final) and for which he/ she has not refused treatment, he/ she will not be required to pay any Bond money but will have to pay the cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL.

3. NOW THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION is such that the post-doctoral student after grant of Short Service Commission serves for a period of five years or cause to be paid to the Government the amount due to his/ her in contravention of the bond agreement then this bond shall be void, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force.
