### **ETHICS COMMITTEE**

- An institutional ethical committee has been established to review the research activities of the under graduate and post graduate students. The IEC holds a meeting and discusses the research protocols and sanctions the projects found feasible. The purpose is to protect human subjects during research thus ensuring highest ethical standards and conduct in all research carried out.
- An independent body constituted of medical, non-medical, scientific and non scientific members whose responsibility is to ensure the protection of the rights, safety and well- being of human subjects involved in the trial by reviewing, approving and providing continuing review of trial protocol and amendments.
- **Functions :**
  - The committee reviews the research proposals of undergraduate and post graduate students.
  - The committee ensures that rights of the study subjects are protected.
  - To provide competent review of all ethical aspects of the project and undertake review free from bias and influence.
  - To protect dignity, rights and well-being of all the potential research participants.
  - To ensure universal ethical values and international research standards in terms of local community values and customs.
  - Ensures collection of informed consent from the subjects.
  - It ensures the confidentiality and privacy of the subjects at all times.
